Boost for families in St Helens with plans for new children's services and birthing facilities

Families in St Helens are set to benefit from improved community health facilities, with plans moving ahead for a new **Children's and Families Community Hub** to be delivered at Lowe House Health Centre, including a new **midwifery unit, birthing centre and birthing pools**.

The plans will see over £700,000 invested in new facilities that will help reduce pressure on local hospitals by offering alternative birthing options for families in the local community, as well a range of other family and children's

Investment in new and improved mental health provision in Streatham

Health services in south London have received a significant boost with the completion of a £2.3m project to deliver new and improved facilities at **Gracefield Gardens Health Centre in Streatham**.

The ground floor area of Gracefield Gardens has been redeveloped to create a new Living Well Network offering residents a **single access point for mental health services**. The new hub brings together 4 different mental health organisations in one space, reducing duplication and fragmentation of mental health services across the local area. In addition, the



in

two existing GP surgeries at Gracefield Gardens have seen their space in the building redesigned to **create more space allowing them to better-serve the growing local population**.
