The Nelson Health Centre welcomes Stephen Hammond MP



The Nelson Health Centre in Wimbledon today welcomed local MP Stephen Hammond on a visit to see the vital role the building plays in supporting community health.

The Nelson in Kingston Road, Wimbledon offers residents a range of vital services including GP surgeries; mental health provision; minor surgery facilities; support services for older people; specialist outpatient clinics; together with a café and pharmacy all helping to create an important community hub. The Nelson has also invested in a number of community initiatives to help support local health and social care needs, including a long-running partnership with AFC Wimbledon.
